Midi Hardware

Choice of 61-note Fatar keyboards with simulated tracker touch.
Detachable pedalboard.
Two or three expression pedals with adjustable tension.
Up to 16 thumb pistons per manual.
Four solid brass foot pistons.

Audio Hardware

Headphone out socket located underneath keyboard shelf.
Low-latency USB soundcard (Focusrite or Motu).
Optional powered studio speakers.

Stops

Choice of 22-inch HD touchscreen Iiyama monitors mounted on rigid, adjustable stands, or motorised drawstops. Optional centre screen and Bluetooth page-turner piston.

Computer

To run Hauptwerk software you'll need a computer with plenty of RAM. Sadly AI has monopolised the supply chain, leading to significant price rises. There are limited second hand options. Please enquire for options.

Power

Built-in remote-controlled power distribution.

Lighting

Pedalboard and music desk lighting included.

Delivery & Installation

Free within 150 miles of Gloucester, UK. Beyond this, mileage will be charged by agreement.
Unfortunately I am not currently able to ship outside the UK mainland.

Documentation

Comprehensive user manual and schematics. Ongoing WhatsApp customer support.

Warranty

You'll get an initial snag visit should any problems come to light after installation. After this, travel expenses will apply. This warranty does not include 3rd party electronics, accidental damage or malfunction due to mistreatment or wear and tear.

Payment

For private clients a deposit of £1500 will be payable by BACS. Balance on delivery. Institutions will provide a Purchase Order in lieu of deposit.

Height varies by speaker choice.

Width 142cm (at table height) or 150.5cm (at the widest part of the cornice).
